INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT TO THE PARTY SECRETARY OF THE FOCUS NZ PARTY Business Advisers

Report of the Focus NZ Party Donation Return

We have audited the attached Return of Party Donations and Loans (the 'Return') prepared by the Focus NZ Party for the period 1 January 2014 to 31 December 2014. The Return is prepared in accordance with section 210 and 214c of the Electoral Act 1993. The Return provides information about party donations and loans made to the Focus NZ Party.

This report is made solely to the Party Secretary. Our audit has been undertaken so that we might state to the Party Secretary those matters we are required to state to them in an auditor's report and for no other purpose. To the fullest extent permitted by law, we do no accept or assume responsibility to anyone other than the Party Secretary, for our audit work, for this report, or for the opinions we have formed.

Party Secretary's Responsibilities

The Party Secretary is responsible for the preparation of a Return which fairly reflects the party donations and loans received by the Focus NZ Party for the period 1 January 2014 to 31 December 2014 in accordance with the Electoral Act 1993.

Auditor's Responsibility

Our responsibility to express an independent opinion on the Return in terms of the requirements of section 210 and 214c of the Electoral Act 1993. Our engagement has been conducted in accordance with SAE 3100 Compliance Engagements to provide reasonable assurance that the Focus NZ Party's Return has compiled with section 210 and 214c of the Electoral Act 1993. These procedures have been undertaken to form an opinion as to whether the Focus NZ Party's Return has compiled, in all material respects, with section 210 and 214c of the Electoral Act 1993.

Other than in our capacity as auditor, we have no relationship with or interests in the Focus NZ Party.

Qualified Opinion on the Return

Control over income from donations, whether in the form of cash or as donated goods and services, prior to being recorded by an organisation is limited, and there are no practical audit procedures to determine the effect of this limited control. Accordingly, an auditor of an organisation receiving significant amounts of donations usually qualifies their opinion to reflect the practical limitation of an audit in this area.

Due to the nature of these issues, we do not believe there is further information that can be provided to us by the Focus NZ Party which would allow us to determine the effect of this limited control.

Proper accounting records of party donations and loans, once entered in those records, have been kept by the Focus NZ Party as far as appears from our examination of those records.

In our opinion, except for adjustments that might have been found necessary had we been able to obtain sufficient evidence concerning income from donations and funding from loans the attached Return of Party Donations and Loans fairly reflects, in accordance with section 210 and 214c of the Electoral Act 1993, the party donations received by the Focus NZ Party for the period 1 January 2014 to 31 December 2014.

In forming our opinion we were reliant on the information provided to us by the Party Secretary.

I confirm and take responsibility for the following representations after taking all reasonable steps to assure myself of them:

- 1 The return has been prepared in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Act.
- I am responsible for establishing and maintaining a system of internal control designed to provide reasonable assurance as to the integrity and reliability of the return. I have done this, and all explanations or demonstrations of this to you have been complete and accurate.
- 3 All records, documents and accounts (records) have been kept by the Party (including subsidiary entities) and made available to you, and these materials will be retained in accordance with the requirements of the Act.

- 6.2 Any loans entered into during the year of less than or equal to \$15,000 if the loan exceeds \$15,000 when aggregated with all other loans entered into during the year by the same lender;
- 6.3 The number and aggregate amount of all other loans entered into of not less than \$1,500 and not more than \$15,000.
