The Electoral Commission is an Independent Crown Entity and is responsible for the conduct of elections. The Commission is also responsible for the administration of election advertising and providing guidance to assist candidates, parties, third parties and the public in respect of election advertising and broadcasting.

Under the Broadcasting Act, an election programme cannot be broadcast on radio or TV outside the election period (from writ day to the day before the election). The definition of an election programme in the Broadcasting Act includes a programme that appears to encourage or persuade voters to vote, or not to vote, for a political party or candidate. There are exceptions to this including editorial content such as news items and/or when the decision to use content in the programme is at the discretion of the editor.
