WHO MUST FILE A RETURN?

All electorate candidates at the 2017 general election must de a return of candidate donations and election expenses. Even if you have no donations or expenses to declare, you MUST still complete the candidate return recording 'NIL' donations or expenses.

KEEPING RECORDS OF DONATIONS AND EXPENSES

Candidates must keep good records of all candidate donations and candidate expenses. Candidates must keep invoices and receipts for all election expenses of \$50 or more for three years after returns are Led.
